

Dr. Ailawadhi is a Professor with the Division of Hematology-Oncology at Mayo Clinic in Jacksonville. His career focus has been on treatment of plasma cell disorders with core research efforts in understanding the epidemiology and pathophysiology of these disorders, evaluating the benefit of various therapeutic strategies in different populations based on racial-ethnic and socioeconomic diversity, as well as developing novel therapeutics by means of conducting several phase 1 through phase 3 clinical trials for novel drugs including cellular therapy such as car T-cell treatment. Dr. Ailawadhi also leads Mayo Clinic's International Cancer Center and is focused on expanding and implementing the Mayo model of care and vision across the world.
